Visit to Woodside Biodiversity Education Centre @ AFCD

The Faculty of Science and Technology had organized visit to the Woodside Biodiversity Education Centre on 20 September 2019. **34 year 1** students from **Associate of Science in Environmental Studies** (who studied "Introduction to Environmental Conservation" course) joined this field trip. It was led by Judy KIU.

Woodside Biodiversity Education Centre situated at Mount Parker Road, Quarry Bay. This 3,386 square metre Centre comprises **three** themed exhibition galleries introducing Hong Kong's precious natural resources and biodiversity, multi-function conference room, resources centre, activity room and a nature garden.

The Centre aims to foster public awareness, knowledge and understanding the inherent value of Hong Kong's biodiversity assets and to marshal public support and action for nature conservation.

Government staff first gave an introduction to the students, then showed them around the centre learning different kinds of habitats (wetlands, forests, mangrove, freshwater streams and marine areas). Afterwards, students had opportunities to study in an outdoor environment.
